On Saturday 6th August the Kesgrave Community Centre will host the sixth annual festival from 11.45am to 10.45pm. All proceeds will be donated to two of our essential local charities: the St Elizabeth Hospice and East Anglian Air Ambulance.

Last year's event was once again a huge success with the organising committee donating £11,000 to St Elizabeth Hospice and EAAH. This was raised through ticket sales, events and donations from local businesses. As a result of all the events organised by the KMP team we have managed to donate over £70,000 in the past six years. KMP 2011 will be a repeat of previous years and will see 11 performers play throughout the day on the main stage with a mixture of local, new and experienced bands. The main hall in

the Community Centre will again host this year's "Live Lounge" giving people the opportunity to enjoy live acoustic music from a further nine performers. We have created a relaxing lounge atmosphere where festival goers can kick back & relax.

The rules that we've had to implement can be found on our web site at [www.kesgravemusicfestival.com](http://www.kesgravemusicfestival.com) but please note a few of the more important ones:

- No glass to taken onto the field;
- Restrictions on alcohol coming onto the field at our discretion;
- No unaccompanied under 18's - entry only with a responsible adult;
- Please bring ID to avoid disappointment;
- No re-entry with alcohol or after 9.30pm;
- No car parking in the Community Centre this year.
